The Woman's Club of North Myrtle Beach was organized in 1973 and federated in 1974. Operating under the larger organizational umbrella of the General Federation of Women's Clubs, our club goals are aimed at community, service, leadership, and individual growth.

Instructions and Requirements:

1. Applicants must be a senior graduating from North Myrtle Beach High School.
2. Applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll at a four year university or technical/community college and attend as a full time student.
3. Applicants must submit two letters of reference: one from a teacher or administrator from North Myrtle Beach High School, and one from a community member that knows the applicant outside of school.
4. A transcript must be submitted with a minimum GPA of 2.5.
5. A list of known scholarships you will be receiving.

Submit a letter signed and dated to include the following information:

- a. Name, age, address, phone number, and email.
- b. A brief introduction of yourself and the name of the school you will be attending.
- c. Explain why receiving this scholarship is important to you, and if there is a need for financial assistance.
- d. Community and extracurricular involvement, outline any participation in Woman's Club events.
- e. Work History
- f. Describe your own unique community service project or fundraiser.
What organization would it benefit? What type of event would you create?

All information will be kept confidential.

Missing information may result in applications not being eligible for consideration.

Applications must be submitted by **Friday, April 24, 2026**.
